ITTC Regulatory Plan – Fiscal Year 2023

Approved by the Commission on June 16, 2022

Introduction:

The Iowa Telecommunications and Technology Commission (ITTC) is required by Executive Order #9 to prepare a regulatory plan listing each regulatory action or potential rule currently under active consideration or development that the ITTC reasonably expects to issue in proposed or final form for the coming fiscal year, excluding those rules that do not have a substantial impact on the legal rights, privileges, or duties of persons. A copy of the plan is to be provided to the Administrative Rules Coordinator by August 1st of each year.

Regulatory Objectives:

The ITTC issues only those administrative rules that are authorized by state or federal law and specifically aid in interpreting Iowa Code Chapter 8D and other applicable law in serving the public need. The ITTC was established under Chapter 8D and has sole authority to supervise the management, development, and operation of the network. The ITTC is directed to coordinate communications of state government, effect maximum practical consolidation and joint use of communications services, and ensure that the network operates in an efficient and responsible manner.

Contemplated rule-making initiatives and legal basis for each:

- No specific rule changes are currently required by the ITTC.
- Corrective amendments or other potential changes, if identified and approved by the ITTC, may be proposed during FY 2023.
