REINVESTMENT BACK TO IOWA ———

In FY 2023, ICN reinvested \$23M back into the private sector with \$9.1M going to private telecoms.

AGENCY FOCUSES MAJOR PROJECTS

AGGREGATION EQUIPMENT UPGRADE

Implementation of the 10Gb converged aggregation network for 156 sites.

- Allows Ethernet and IP services to pass through the network on a redundant and more resilient infrastructure.
- · Provides an efficient, diverse network with greater capacity.

STATE FIREWALL DECENTRALIZATION

The second phase includes providing individualized solutions to government agencies.

- Add capabilities like intrusion prevention, content filtering, anti-malware and more.
- Explore enhanced reporting for agencies.

ADDITIONAL PROJECTS

- Design and installation of a FirstNet failover solution for HSEMD's 911 system. Currently the solution is deployed to over 70 PSAPs.
- · Expanded access to and availability of colocation/disaster recovery facilities at JFHQ and other data center locations.
- Telecommunications Support for State Agency Realignment.
