STATE NETWORKING CONNECTOR

Higher Education Internet2 membership is available to any not-for-profit, postsecondary degree-granting institution that is accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency as determined by the U.S. Secretary of Education.

Higher Education Members must establish a connection to the Internet2 Network through a regional Research and Education Network member/connector.

ICN connects directly to the Great Plains Network (GPN) via Iowa State University. In addition, the ICN peers with other organizations that connect to Internet2.
